

## 2020 Blair Crop Hunger Walk - October 11, 2020



**First Lutheran and First United Methodist Churches** are partnering together this year to host a “virtual walk” in support of fighting hunger both here and around the world. What is a “Virtual Walk” you say? To keep everyone safe and healthy, Walks are going virtual – either walking alone, with immediate family or in small groups walking a safe distance apart. The work of CWS and our local hunger agencies continues – and with the possibility of a global famine on the horizon, raising money for vulnerable people is more needed than ever. 25% of the Walk proceeds will be directed to the Washington County Food Pantry.

**How do I participate?** Click on **REGISTER** at <https://www.crophungerwalk.org/blairne> You may sign up as a solo walker or Team. Select the “VIRTUAL” option when registering, ask others to donate, identify a route and join other walkers around the community or walk solo on Sunday, October 11<sup>th</sup>. Can’t walk that day – then select another on your own.
